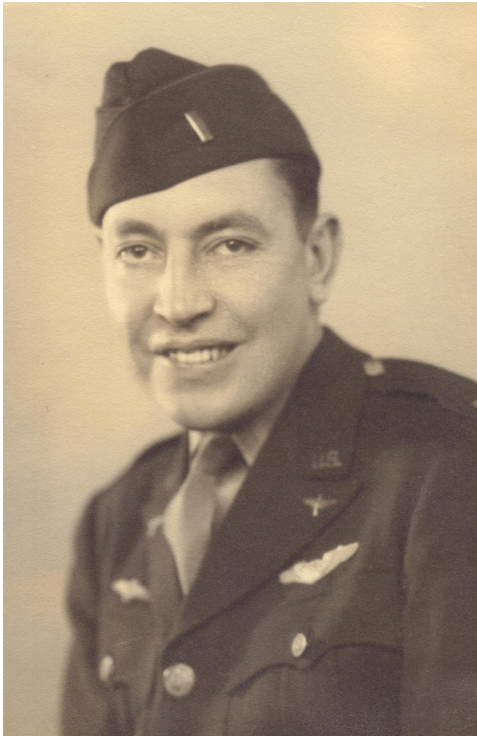


KING, Garrett C.
