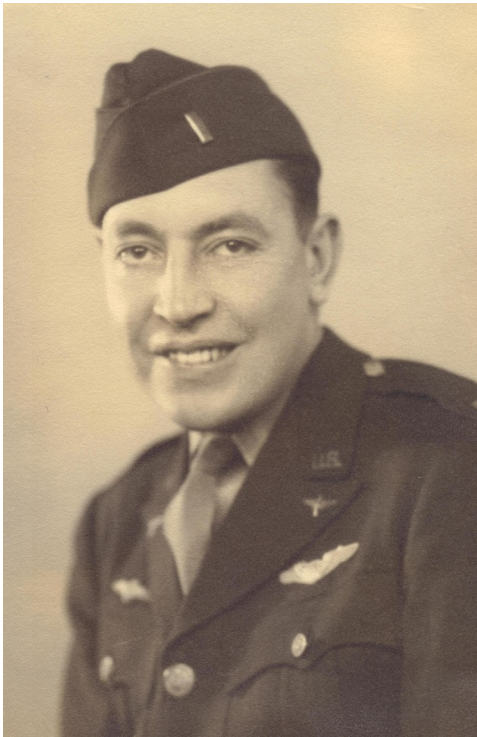


# KING, Garrett C.

14 JUN 43 Communications lost with King while he was on a local flight practicing a homing with MOR. Shortly after his flaming a/c crashed 2 miles E of Swaffham. It is believed his a/c was struck by lightning while flying through a thunderhead.
