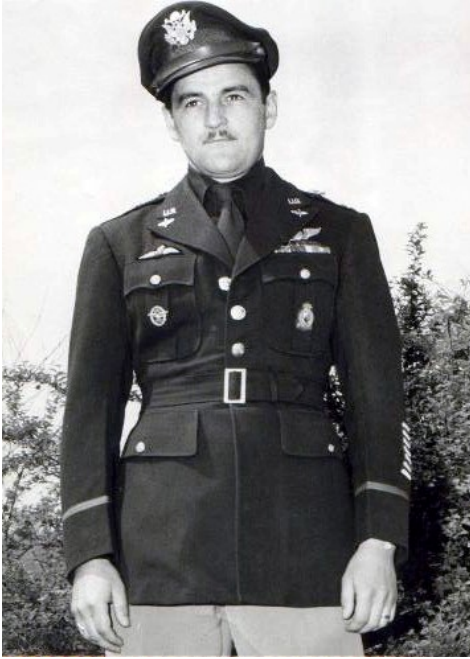


# CARLOW, Earle W.

21 MAR 44 Aircraft struck in the coolant system by ground fire while strafing an airdrome. Fifteen minutes after heading for home the engine caught fire and he bailed out at 1,500', his Mustang exploding on impact about a mile north of where he landed.

Initially captured, he escaped on 7 MAY 44 then successfully evaded, eventually returning to the UK via Spain on 10 JUN 44.
