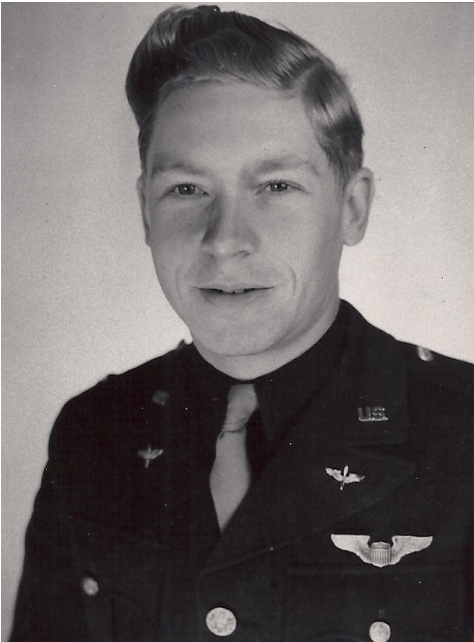


# GREEN, Kenneth
