- DEC 42 Returned to the U.S. for a bond drive with 6 other former Eagles; promoted to 1st Lieutenant while in the Z.I.
- 5 JUL 43 Promoted to Captain
- 4 OCT 43 Designated Squadron Operations Officer
- 30 NOV 43 Promoted to Major  
Completes tour of 50 missions; transferred to 12th Repl. Pool
- JUL 44 Returned to Debden; assigned to 4th Headquarters Squadron or the 336th Fighter Squadron.
- 3 AUG 44 Aircraft suffered an engine failure during escort mission to Joigny, France. Jettisoned canopy and helmet at 16,000'; rode aircraft down to 3,000' then rolled it over and bailed out, landing south of Caen. POW. (MACR 7453)
