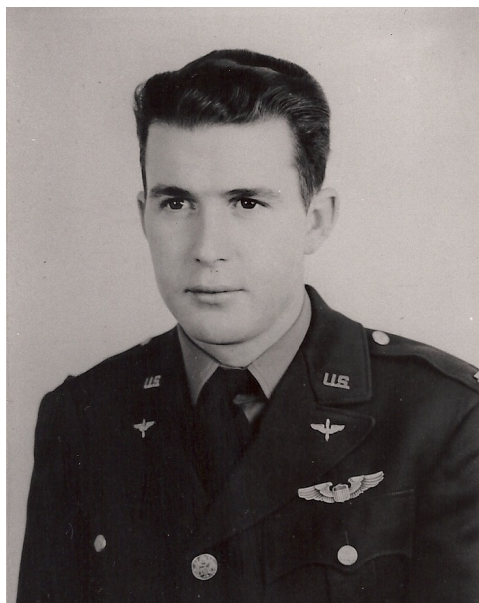

Depot, flight encountered severe weather
with zero visibility down to the deck.
While attempting to get below the cloud
cover and locate a field, a/c struck the
side of a mountain. KIFA
