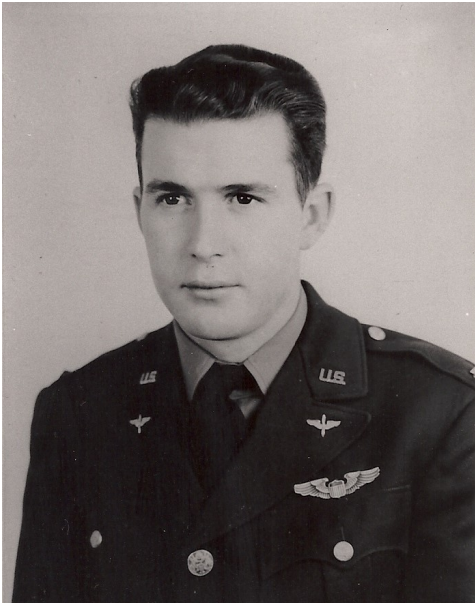


# FREDERICK, Harold H.

1 JUN 44 Designated Flight Commander C Flight

6 JUN 44 Shot down by flak while strafing a truck convoy. EVD (MACR 5609)

29 MAY 45 On a routine ferry mission to the Speke Depot, flight encountered severe weather with zero visibility down to the deck. While attempting to get below the cloud cover and locate a field, a/c struck the side of a mountain. KIFA
