2 OCT 44 Returning from an escort mission to Hamm, Germany, his aircraft was seen flying erratically at 23,000' before suddenly pitching nose-up and then diving straight into the ground near Terwolde, Netherlands disintegrating on impact. Since he did not respond to attempts to reach him via the R/T, it was believed he was incapacitated by an oxygen system failure.
