19 MAY 44 Aircraft struck in the coolant system by flak at 28,000'. Turned for home, flying about 30 minutes before the engine began belching smoke and quit. He rolled the aircraft over and bailed out at 9,000'. His Mustang crashed about 6 miles SW of Nienburg, Germany.
