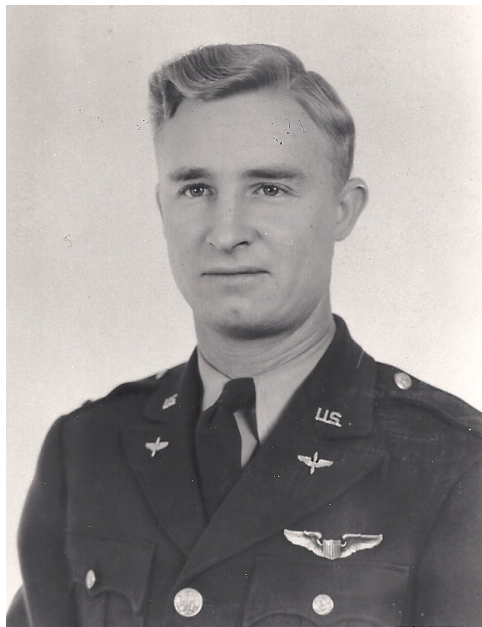


# LINES, Ted E.
