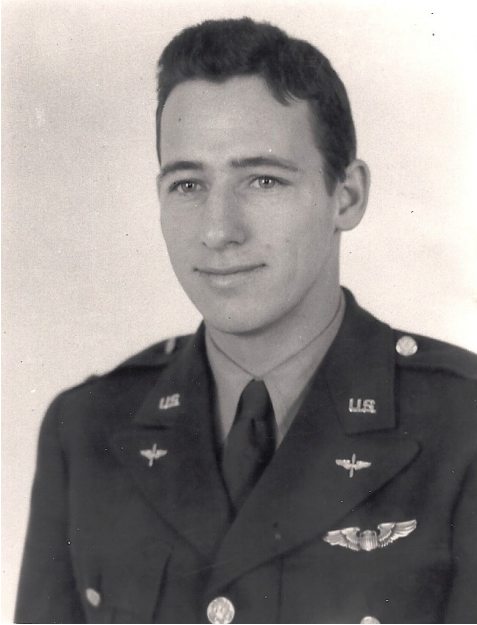


JOINER, Joseph H.

“A rough show today. Took Libs to Ruhland then strafed Neuhausen airdrome, south of Berlin. Our SQD. destroyed 31 planes. I got four. When we returned to England the clouds were down to the deck. My number two man was killed, Fred Hall. Hagan had to bail out again. Weather like that doesn't make for Long Life.”
